## LINCMASTER “THIEF STOPPERS” HD HITCHLOK (50mm Ball)



**The Lincmaster Hitchlok** provides a trailer security system which effectively immobilises plant and equipment against unauthorised removal. It is manufactured from Heavy Duty Steel Plate and is finished in a weather-proof powder coat paint finish. Models from the 50mm Hitchlok system will fit virtually all manufacturers ball hitches including Bradley, Al-ko, Albe, Avonride and Indespension. Comes complete with the proven Lincmaster 10 pin radial tumbler lock system and with a hook to accept Lincmaster HD Security Chain. We recommend the use of HD Security Chain to prevent theft by lifting or dragging.

**EASY TO FIT:** Simply unlock and slide the “shoe” out of the outer case. Locate the 50mm sectional ball into the trailer hitch socket and attach the chain to the retaining hook. Slide the outer case back over the shoe and lock into position.

### THE CHAIN

13mm High Security Chain, exclusive to Lincmaster, is manufactured from Alloy steel grade 80 which is toughened and then case hardened to a depth of 40 Thou’ conforming to BS4942 Part 5 and is resistant to files, hacksaws, levers, freezing and 4 foot boltcroppers as well as being difficult to attack with power tools.

### THE LOCK

The highest specification locking system available, the Radial Ten Pin tumbler lock, which has over one million combinations forms an integral part of the Lincmaster product range. There is no known picking tool and it has a drill proof centre with keys that cannot be duplicated.

## **The Home Office have said that trailers are now the most stolen items.**

How do they get stolen? – All trailers and trailer mounted equipment now utilise couplings that came from the caravan market. You know the type – you were told that they already offered security because the coupling head has a lock in it.

So no need for you to worry about security then.

Unfortunately not true since all that the lock does is to lock the handle. The thief only has to file a flat on the ball on his vehicle and the 'locked' head fits – and off goes your valuable asset!

But you have already taken the precaution to use a hitch lock just like those used on caravans – sorry again to have to tell you that the thieves only have to run a chain or rope over the A-frame and off it goes again!

So what do you do to deal with the problem?

Many years ago Lincmaster investigated the problem and developed a specifically designed solution for the contract market – Lincmaster customers tell us of their 100% success - The Lincmaster **HD Hitchlok**

This provides a trailer security system that effectively immobilises the trailer against unauthorised removal. Models from the 50mm HD Hitchlok system are made to fit virtually all manufacturers ball hitches including Avonride, Al-ko, Albe, Bradley and Indespension.

Even more importantly the Lincmaster HD Hitchlok is manufactured with a hook inside it to utilise Lincmaster **HD Security Chain** to prevent theft by lifting or dragging away.

Since we are aware that thieves often unbolt the bolts holding the coupling to the trailer frame then we always recommend that they be touch welded to prevent thieves replacing with their own coupling.

Lincmaster **HD Security Chain** – specifically developed for use with Lincmaster products and complete with either one reeving eye for use with HD Hitchlocks (suffix S) or two reeving eyes (suffix D) for use with other 'Thief Stopper' products. Designed to resist files, hacksaws, levers, freezing, **4-foot** boltcroppers and to be difficult to cut with power tools.

As we know that some thieves are more determined than others we have developed a range of additional solutions. You can add these to make the thieves life more difficult and to move them onto to other softer targets..
